Overview of Responsibilities

Incidental loss can be controlled through good management in combination with active employee involvement. Safety is the direct responsibility of all Managers, Supervisory Staff and Employees.

Job Role	Responsibilities
All Employees	 Follow the established safe work procedures. Wear and maintain personal protective equipment as required. Comply with all health and safety policies and procedures. Fulfill your health and safety responsibilities.
Foremen	 Ensure the safety of employees under your direction. Assist Supervisors with the implementation of the Safety Management System. Set a good example.
Supervisors	 Implement the Safety Management System for your area of responsibility. Promote health and safety throughout the company.
General Manager	 Monitor the implementation of the Safety Management System. Assist Foremen and Supervisors with the implementation of the SMS.
Senior Manager	 Provide the resources to implement and maintain an effective and compliant Safety Management System. Monitor the implementation of the Safety Management System.
Contractors	 Complete a Contractor Orientation. Report all unsafe or unhealthy acts or conditions. Report all near-misses, incidents, injuries, occupational illnesses and bodily pain promptly.
Visitors	Obtain a Visitor Orientation from a suitably qualified employee.
